Dillard at and before the unsealing and delivery of these presents the receipt
whereof they do hereby acknowledge and themselves to be therewith fully
satisfied contented and paid they the said John Lee and Elizabeth his
wife have granted bargained sold aliened and confirmed and by these
presents do grant bargain sell alien and confirmed unto him the
said Richmond Dillard his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract
or parcel of land lying in the aforesaid County of Southampton on
the South Side of the Cedar Swamp containing by estimation three
