This Indenture made this 22nd day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eleven Between John Lee and Elizabeth Lee his wife late of the County of Southampton but now residing in the City of Richmond Virginia of the one part and Richmond Dillard of the other part Witnesseth that they the said John Lee and Elizabeth his wife for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred Dollars Virginia Money to them in hand paid by the said Richmond Dillard before the making and delivery of these presents the receipts whereof we the said John Lee and Elizabeth his wife do hereby acknowledge and themselves to be indebted to satisfy the same and paid have granted bargained sold aliened and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain sell alien and confirm unto the said Richmond Dillard his heirs and assigns forever One certain tract or
