This Indenture made this 22nd day of November in the year of Our Lord One eight hundred and eleven Between Cordell Brantley & Phely his wife of the County of Southampton and Parish of St Lukes of the one part and Elizabeth Cloud of the aforesaid County and Parish of the other part Witnesses that the said Cordell Brantley and Phely his wife for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred Dollars to them in hand paid on or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof in the said Cordell Brantley & Phely his wife hath fully acknowledge hath granted bargained & sold alone & confirmed unto the said Elizabeth Cloud her heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land containing one hundred and seven and half acres and bounded as followeth to wit beginning at a white Oak a corner in Soil Westrocks line thence along his line
