The said Eliza Bailey have granted bargained and sold New style off and Confirm unto the said Wm Lane and John Davis one certain tract or parcel of land containing two hundred & forty acres be the same more or less lying and being in the County of Southampton and bounded as follows Vizt Beginning at the lightwood Swamp in Moyer Dooths line thence South East thence in James Booth
