This Indenture made this nineteenth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and three Between Benjamin Johnson of Shadock and Mary Johnson his wife of the county of Southampton of the one part and Arthur Dole of the said county of the other part Witnesseth that the said Benjamin Johnson of Shadock and Mary Johnson his wife for and in consideration of the sum of sixty dollars Current money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Arthur Dole on or before the sealing of these presents the receipt whereof the said Benjamin and Mary Johnsons doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained and sold aliened released and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien release and confirm unto the said Arthur Dole his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the county of Southampton and on the south side of Shadock swamp containing twenty acres more or less and bounded as follows vizt beginning at the run of the Poley Branch adjoining the said Arthur Dole land that he purchased of Benjamin Crumpler thence up the run of said Poley Branch to the spring lane road thence down the road eastward to a Turkey oak standing on the south side of said road adjoining the said land purchased of Benjamin Crumpler to have and to hold the aforesaid granted land and premises unto the said Arthur Dole his heirs and assigns forever and also the remainder and remainders reversion and reversions rents issues and Profits of the said tract or parcel of land to the only proper use and behoof of the said Arthur Dole his heirs and assigns forever -
