This Indenture made this ninth day of December in
 the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & eleven
 Between William Bailey of Southampton county and state
 of Virginia of the first part and Duncan Day Briggs
 of Orange County and state of North Carolina of the other
 part: Witnesseth that the said Duncan Day Briggs
 hath for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred
 & forty dollars to him in hand paid the receipt whereof
 he doth hereby acknowledge, bargained & sold & by these
 presents do bargain and sell unto the said Bailey his heirs
 &c. all his right title and interest to and in favour of
 said Bailey that he hath or might, ever did now has or
 may hereafter have to the whole and every part of a legacy
 left the said Briggs by his uncle Sam. Briggs in his last
 will and now by these presents and in consideration as aforesaid
 the said D. D. Briggs doth duly relinquish and release
 all and every part of in and to the legacy to which he is
 or might or may be intitled as Legatee of said Samuel
 Briggs dec'd to and in favour of the said William Bailey
 his heirs executors & adm^{rs} and do moreover ever warrant
 and defend the same - In Witness whereof I do hereby
 set my hand and affix my seal the day and year above
 written
