

At a court held for the County of Southampton the 18th day of March 1812 this Indenture with the receipt thereon endorsed was acknowledged by Nelson Wade and Patience his wife the parties thereto she being first privately examined as the law directs is ordered to be recorded.

This Indenture made the second day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twelve between Edwin Williams of the one part and Nelson Wade of the other part all of Southampton County and State of Virginia Witnesseth that whereas William Charles stood justly indebted Jos Denson in the sum of two hundred twenty nine dollars & six Cents also in the sum of seventy five dollars & fourteen Cents due to Joseph Denson ex. of Jordan Denson decd. and being willing and desirous to secure the payment thereof did on the 17th of August 1809 for the consideration aforesaid make and execute a deed in trust to the above named Edwin Williams for the purpose aforesaid and therein conveyed unto the said Edwin Williams one certain tract and parcel of land lying in the aforesaid County of Southampton containing by estimation one hundred and eleven acres more or less and bounded as is described in the deed in trust aforesaid and which is recorded in the County Court of Southampton reference to the deed being had the bounds well appear and whereas the said Edwin Williams did accordingly and in conformity to the trust reposed in him on the fourteenth day of December 1811 set up the said land to the highest bidder having first duly advertised the time and place of sale according to the conditions of the deed in trust, and Nelson Wade became the purchaser thereof for the sum of three hundred and seventy six dollars and one Cent now this Indenture further Witnesseth that I Edwin Williams for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred and seventy six dollars and one Cent to me in hand paid the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge and through acquit and discharge the said Nelson Wade the tract of land aforesaid with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any way appertaining and the said Edwin Williams at any time hereafter shall not ask claim or demand
