This Indenture made this ninth day of September  
in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred and eleven  
Between Thomas Newsom and Elizabeth his wife of the county  
of Southampton and state of Virginia of the one part and  
Robert Williams of the aforesaid county and state of the other  
part. Witnesseth that the said Thomas Newsom and Elizabeth  
his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred  
dollars lawful money to them in hand paid at or before the  
sealing and delivery of these presents doth grant bargain  
and sell unto Robert Williams his heirs and assigns forever  
one certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being  
in the aforesaid county of Southampton and bounded as  
followeth Viz<sup>t</sup> Beginning at a small post standing
