Holliman

This Indenture made this 16<sup>th</sup> day of March 1812 be-  
tween Joseph I Womble of the first part, John Harris  
of the second part and John Holliman of the third  
part. Witnesseth that whereas the said John Harris hath  
become bound as security for the said Joseph I Womble  
in a bond to Jordan Coker for the sum of \$161.67 cents  
dated 14<sup>th</sup> Instant, and payable on the 1<sup>st</sup> day Jan'y 1813  
the same being for the purchase of a tract of land in  
Southampton county, now therefor, this Indenture Witness-  
eth that in order to save harmless the said John Harris  
and indemnify him for becoming security as aforesaid  
and also in consideration of the sum of one Dollar in hand  
paid by the said Joseph I Womble hath granted bargained  
and sold unto the said John Holliman and his heirs all  
the land the he said Joseph I Womble now possesses  
say one hundred and four acres more or less to have and  
to hold the said tract or tracts, parcel or parcels of land  
with it or their appurtenances to him the said John  
Holliman and his heirs, and the said Joseph I Womble  
for himself, his heirs exec<sup>s</sup> and adm<sup>r</sup>. the aforesaid tract  
or tracts parcel or parcels of land together with its app<sup>r</sup>  
or their appurtenances unto him the said John Holliman  
his heirs and assigns, doth shall, and, will forever warrant  
and defend - Upon Trust nevertheless and for the purpose  
herein after mentioned, that if the said John Harris  
his heirs &c should by due process of law be compelled to  
pay the aforesaid sum of money, or any part thereof, then  
it shall and be lawfully for the said John Holliman  
his heirs &c the aforesaid land or lands and premises or  
any part thereof to expose at public sale to the highest  
bidder for the best price that can be got in ready money  
after giving ten days previous notice by advertising the same  
in some nearest public newspaper or at the court house  
door of the county aforesaid, and the money arising from
