

such sale to be applied to the payment of such sum or sums of money as the said John Harris his heirs &c may have paid with interest thereon and cost, and all charges incidental to such sale and the overplus if any to pay unto the said Joseph J Wombell his heirs &c and it is further covenanted and agreed that the said John Holliman his heirs &c shall have power (full) to make and execute a deed or deeds to the purchaser or purchasers for the land, or lands above mentioned, in as ample a manner, and the same shall be as legal to all intents & purposes whatsoever as tho' the same were made, done or executed by the said Joseph J Wombell and it is further understood to be the true intent and meaning of these presents, that in case the said Joseph J Wombell his heirs &c should pay and satisfy the aforesaid debt or bond so as to save harmless the said John Harris his heirs &c that then and in that case the trust herein given shall be released and annulled and the aforesaid estate and all interest therein revert in the said Joseph J Wombell his heirs &c in the same manner as if this Indenture had never been made (or entered into) In testimony whereof the said parties have hereunto set their hands and seals this 16th
