This Indenture made this 5th day of February 1812 Between Joel Maclemore and Elizabeth his wife of Southampton County of the one part and Joshua Kersey of said county of the other part Witnesseth that the said Joel Maclemore and Elizabeth his wife in consideration of the sum of two hundred & twenty five dollars to them in hand paid by the said Joshua Kersey at or before the enacting and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged Have bargained and sold and by these presents do and each of them doth bargain and sell unto the said Joshua Kersey his heirs or assigns a certain tract piece or parcel of land lying and being in the said County of Southampton and bounded as followeth Beginning at a Haw bush in Scarboroughs line thence by the land of Scarboroughs line to Haly Forsters line thence to the road thence down the road to the first station, To have and to hold the said premises with all the appurtenances therunto belonging and all and singular other the premises herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part or parcel thereof with every of their rights members & appurtenances unto the said Joshua Kersey his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only proper use & behoof of him the said Joshua Kersey his heirs & assigns forever and the said Joel Maclemore and Elizabeth his wife for themselves and their heirs the said with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Joshua Kersey his heirs assigns forever free from the claims or claims of them the said Joel Maclemore and Elizabeth
