May 1812 This Indenture was acknowledged by Etheldred
Vaper party thereto and ordered to be recorded

Vaper This Indenture made this 11th day of December 1811
Between Etheldred Vaper of the one part and James Vaper
Vaper of the other part all of the county of Southampton and state
of Virginia Witnesseth, that for the natural love and affec-
tion which I have and do bear towards my son James
Vaper and as well as for and in consideration of the sum
of ten dollars to me in hand paid the receipt whereof
I the said Etheldred Vaper doth hereby acknowledge have
granted bargained and sold and do by these presents grant
bargain, sell alien, and confirm unto the said James Vaper
his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract and parcel of land
called and known by the name of the black tract which said
tract and parcel of land was directed by the last will and tes-
tament of Franklin Clark dec^d to be sold by his executor
to his said will, after the death of Mary Clark widow of
the said Franklin Clark when and where I the said Etheldred
Vaper as executor of the said Franklin Clark became the
purchaser - Containing by estimation three hundred and
seventy acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows
to wit By Etheldred Vapers line John A. Ford Melchisedec
Pitman and Joseph Lane thence running up Tarpahanna
swamp to the old Mill to the said Vapers line To have and
to hold the said tract and parcel of land with the appurtenances
unto the said James Vaper his heirs &c together with all the
profits commodities advantages and hereditaments whatsoever
thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining and the rever-
sion and reversions remainder and remainders rents &c issues
of the said land and premises and every and parcel thereof &
all of the estate right title, Interest, claim and demand what-
soever of him the said Etheldred Vaper his heirs executors and
administrators - To the only proper use and behoof of
