Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of twenty five dollars to them in hand paid by the said William Hurst the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged. They the said Stephen Barrett and Jemima his wife hath bargained and sold unto the said William Hurst and doth by these presents grant bargain sell, alien and confirm unto him the said William Hurst all right title property and interest which they the said Stephen Barrett and Jemima his wife has in and to a certain tract of land lying and being in the aforesaid county of Southampton whereon Harry Hurst (William's mother) now resides and bounded by the well known lines of Jiles Joyner Jordan Tick Jiles Barrett and Statcher Bryant containing one hundred and ten acres more or less to have and to hold unto the said William Hurst and his heirs forever against the claim or claims of him the said Stephen and Jemima his wife
