William Doyal of the county of Southampton and parish of
Stottoway of the one part and John Doyal of the same county
and parish of the other part Witnesseth that the said William
Doyal for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dol-
lars good and lawful money of Virginia to him in hand paid
by the said John Doyal, the receipt whereof the said William
Doyal doth acknowledge himself fully and amply satisfied and
paid, hath granted bargained sold aliened infeoffed and confirmed
and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto
the said John Doyal all that tract or parcel of land wherein
the said William Doyal now lives situate lying and being in
the county of Southampton aforesaid containing by estimation 129
acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit
Beginning at a pine in William Bradshaws line, thence along
his line to Joseph Bradshaws line thence along Joseph Bradshaws
line to Laurence Joyners where the vacant land crosses the line
thence N 27° E. 22 pole to a small persimmon tree a corner of
John Doyal and the same vacant land thence South 71 West
44 pole to the Viggy Branch and thence up to Laurence
Joyners line and thence along his line to John Williams
thence along his line of marked trees to a pine or c. in John
