This Indenture made this 18th day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twelve between Sally Joyner of the county of Southampton and parish of Stolloway of the one part and Ishabod Johnson of the County and parish aforesaid of the other part Witnesses that the said Sally Joyner for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty dollars current money of Virginia already in hand paid hereby the said Ishabod Johnson at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Sally Joyner do hereby acknowledge and myself thereof fully and entirely satisfied contented and paid have bargained sold and enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents doth
