This Indenture made this 20th day of January in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred and twelve between Joseph Stephenson and Angelina his wife of Ligon County of the one part and Jesse Stephenson of the said County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Joseph Stephenson and Angelina his wife for and in consideration of the sum of seventy five pounds to them in hand paid by the said Jesse Stephenson the receipt whereof the said Joseph Stephenson and Angelina his wife hath granted bargained and sold alien enfeoffed and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said Jesse Stephenson his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land together with the appurtenances thereon, containing by estimation one hundred acres being the same more or less situate lying and being in the County of Southampton and bounded as follows beginning at a corner tree a Miller oak standing in the branch adjoining Benjamin Drews line thence along a line of marked trees to a pine a corner of said Benjamin Drews line thence along a line of marked trees to a corner tree a sweet gum standing in a branch adjoining the said Benjamin Drews thence down the said branch to an elbow tree a white oak in said Benjamin Drews line thence along of marked trees to a pine a corner tree in
