This Indenture made this 14th day of May one
thousand eight hundred and twelve Between Benjamin
Edmunds of the County of Halifax and state of North Car-
olina of the one part and Etheldred Edmunds of the
County of Sanington and State of Virginia of the other part
Witnesseth that the said Benjamin Edmunds for and in
consideration of the sum off two thousand and fifty dollars
to him in hand paid by the said Etheldred Edmunds the
receipt whereof the said Benjamin Edmunds doth hereby
acknowledge hath bargain sold conveyed and delivered and
by these presents doth bargain sell convey and deliver unto
Etheldred Edmunds his heirs & assigns forever one certain
piece and parcel of land lying in the county of Southampton
and parish of St Lukes which said land was devised to me by
Samuel Edmunds in his testament and last will and has been
attested and assigned to me by certain commissioners appointed
by an Interlocutory decree of the County Court of Sanington
pronounced on the 16th day of December 1811 to make division of
the lands whereof Samuel Edmunds died seized and possessed
reference to the will of the said Samuel and the report of the
said commissioners the title well more clearly appear, and which
said piece parcel and tract of land is designated in the said
