Containing by ninety three acres be the same more or less  
and bounded as follows beginning at the main run of the  
Three Creeks in Nancey Rivers land thence along said Rivers line  
to the land belonging to Briggs Baps dec thence along said  
line to the line of David Thomas in the land which he  
bought of that belonged to Joseph Thorpe dec thence  
along said line to John Parkham line thence along said Parkham  
line to the main run of the three creeks thence up the various  
Courses of said creeks to the beginning to have and to hold the  
said land with all the privileges and appurtenances thereof  
unto the said Lucy Long her heirs and assigns forever I do
