Vickrip This Indenture made this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of June one thousand  
hundred and eight hundred and twelve between Joseph Vick and  
Nancy his wife of the county of Southampton parish of  
Northway of the one part and Jesse Vick of the county  
and parish aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the  
said Joseph Vick for and in consideration of the just  
and full sum of Fifty eight pounds Current money  
of Virginia by the said Jesse Vick to him in hand paid  
before the unsealing and delivery of these presents the  
receipt whereof the said Jo Vick and Nancy his wife  
doth hereby acknowledge he the said Jo Vick hath  
granted bargained and sold aliened enfeoffed and by these  
presents doth grant bargain and sell alien enfeoff &  
confirm unto the said Jesse Vick his heirs and assigns  
forever one certain tract of land containing by estimation  
one hundred acres be the same more or less and bounded  
as follows to wit Beginning at the mouth of the dam  
branch in black creek and up the various courses of  
the said branch to the head thence a line of marked trees  
the road to a pine a corner tree of Benj. Hasty's line thence  
a line of marked trees to a pine a corner tree of John  
Gardner's line thence a line of marked trees to the head of  
a small branch thence down the branch of the creek  
thence down the run of the said creek to the beginning  
lying in the county of Southampton and parish  
aforesaid and all the houses out houses edifices buildings  
Woods Ways Water and Watercourses low grounds  
Swamps Marshes, meadows pastures feeding
