certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County
of Southampton, on the north side of the deep branch, and
bounded as follows Viz: beginning at a pine in the run
of the Meadow branch, thence along a line of new marked
trees to a pine in Littleberry Jones' line thence along
Jones' line to run of the deep branch, thence up the run
of said branch, to Richard Plows line, thence along
said line to a dogwood in sd line thence along a line of
New marked trees to a black gum in the run of the new
Meadow branch thence up the run of sd branch to the beginning
the said tract of land to be fifty acres more or less and all the
profits in or upon growing happening or arising and also
the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders with
issues and advantages and every part & parcel thereof and
also all the estate right title, interest claim & demand
whatsoever of ourselves the above mentioned, William Kitching
