This Indenture made this twentieth day of April in the
 year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twelve between
 Peter and Lettison Moore his son both of the county of South
 ampton and state of Virginia. Witnesseth that for and in
 consideration of the natural love and affection which I bear
 to my said son Lettison Moore of the county and state aforesaid
 as well as for the further sum of one dollar to me in hand
 paid by the said Lettison Moore at or before the inscaling
 and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknow-
 ledged have given & granted and by these presents do give &
 grant unto the said Lettison Moore his executors administrators
 and assigns one certain tract or parcel of land lying and being
 in the County & state aforesaid and bounded as follows beginning
 at a gum afore and aft tree of Ethelred Gardners line & make
 a corner by the said Peter Moore himself thence along the said
 Gardners line to a pine a corner of the said Gardners and the
 said Lettison Moore of a fore and aft tree of the said Peter Moore
 thence along the line of the parties to a white oak a corner of
 the parties thence along their line to a red oak thence along
 their line to a Gum a corner of the said parties and
