This Indenture made this 31st day of August A.D. 1812
between Henry Suter of the county of Bedford and State of
North Carolina of the first part & Benjamin Barrett of the same
part and Jacob Barnes of the third part both of the County
of Southampton and state of Virginia witnesses that
whereas he the said Henry Suter doth justly stand in-
debted unto the said Benjamin Barrett in the sum of three
hundred forty seven dollars due by note bearing even date
with these presents and being willing and desirous to secure
the payment of the same and for the further consideration
of the sum of one Dollar to him in hand paid on delivery
of these presents the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged
both bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant
bargain and sell unto him the said Jacob Barnes the fol-
lowing property to wit five negroes named as follows viz
Lack Lee Luff Dead and Peter to him the said Jacob
Barnes his heirs executors administrators or assigns to have
and to hold the said property unto him the said Jacob Barnes
his heirs and assigns forever on special trust and confidence
and he the said Henry Suter for himself his heirs & doth by
these presents warrant and well forever defend unto him the
said Jacob Barnes his heirs and assigns all right and title
property & interest in and to the said property against the
claim or claims of all and every person or persons whatsoever
provided nevertheless that he the said Jacob Barnes shall
at the request of either of the ^{other} two parties proceed to advertise
the said property and make sale thereof for ready money
and after satisfying the said debt together with interest
and costs shall pay the surplus if any to the said Henry
Suter or his order Intention of all which the parties
have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and
year above written in presence of
