 and twelve between Daniel Pond and Polly Pond his wife
 of the County of Southampton of the one part and Henry
 Lenow of the same County of the other part Witnesseth that
 the said Daniel Pond and Polly Pond his wife for and in con-
 sideration of the sum of one hundred and six pounds seven
 and six pence to them in hand paid by the said Henry
 Lenow the receipt whereof the said Daniel Pond and Polly
 Pond his wife doth acknowledge themselves fully and amply
 satisfied and paid hath granted bargained sold and confirmed
 and do by these presents grant bargain sell and confirm unto
 the said Henry Lenow to him and his heirs forever, one certain
 tract or parcel of land and premises situate lying and being
 in the County aforesaid containing by estimation One hundred
 and fifty four acres and bounded as follows (to wit) beginning
 at a red oak a corner in Williams Spiveys line running
 thence North 73 West 34 poles to a pine a corner in Mr
 Spiveys line thence a due North course along Mr Spiveys line
 of marked trees 84 poles to a dead pine stump a corner of E Chas
 Lovey thence N 68 W 94 poles to an old dead pine a corner
 of Widow Mellons John Boath and the Widow Wood thence
 nearly a due South course 212 poles to a pine a corner of Mrs
 Wood
