one dollar to him in hand paid by the said William Pledger the
receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge hath bargained sold &
delivered and do by these presents bargain sell and deliver unto the
said William Pledger his heirs executors adm^r or assigns the
following property to wit one feather bed and furniture one horse
