At a court held for the County of Southampton the 15th day of
January 1813 this Indenture was acknowledged by John Plant
party thereto and ordered to be recorded in

Commissioners of this Indenture made this 29th day of December 1812 between
to Arthur Bowen Micajah Griffin and John Clayton commissioners
Bradshaw appointed by the court of the County of Southampton of the one part
and Richard Bradshaw of the County of Southampton of the other
part Witnesseth that whereas at a Court held for the County of
Southampton aforesaid on the 15th day of February 1802 it was
decreed and ordered that Clark an absent defendant be fore-
closed from all equity of redemption of in and to a certain
piece parcel and tract of land containing two hundred and
fifty acres be the same more or less which said land was con-
veyed in trust to Samuel Wells to secure a debt due to him
and that the said Arthur Bowen Micajah Griffin John
Clayton & Edward M. Tyler or any three of them sell the said
land for cash and pay and satisfy the said Sam Wells his debt
and costs of so much the said land should sell for a reference to
that decree will or all the same clearly appear the said Arthur
Bowen Micajah Griffin and John Clayton of the Commissioners
aforesaid in pursuance of that decree did set up at public auction
the above mentioned premises for cash and the said Richard Brad-
shaw became the purchaser thereof for the sum of one
hundred and ten dollars which said sum they the said Arthur
Bowen Micajah Griffin and John Clayton do hereby acknow-
ledge to have rec^d and do therefrom acquit and discharge
the said Richard Bradshaw his heirs and assigns forever
