or parcel of land containing fifty acres lying or being in the

county of Southampton and bounded as follows first beginning at a Willow oak on said William West line and in Williams

line thence along the latter to a lightwood stake in James

Jones line thence along his line to a well~~oak~~ oak thence along

said line and Anselm Jones line to a corner stake in the
