This Indenture made and entered into this 28th day of
November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
and twelve between Thomas Stanley of the first part and
Bills of the second part Witnesses that the said Thomas Stanley
by hath for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred
dollars to him paid by the above named Silas Bills the
receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath and doth by
these presents grant and lease unto the said Silas Bills for
term of five years commencing the 25th of December next
and expiring the 25th of December 1817 one certain tract
or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton
containing by estimation one hundred and thirty four acres
and bounded by the lands of Arthur A Carr William Allen
John Curl dec^d and Matthias Williams, the said land being
that part of the tract which fell to the said Thomas Stanley
in right of his late wife Polly formerly Polly Williams and a
part of the land which Laurence Williams dec^d seized and
possessed to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land
with every appurtenance thereunto belonging for the full
term of five years commencing from the aforesaid 25th day
of December - In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my
