This Indenture made this tenth day of February in the  
year of our lord one thousand eight hundred and Thirteen  
between James Rockelle of the town of Jerusalem of the one part  
and Joshua Fort of the said town of the other part Witnesseth  
that for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred and  
twenty six dollars in hand paid to him the said James Rockelle  
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath given granted  
bargained sold and delivered unto the said Joshua Fort one  
certain lot of land and the appurtenances thereto belonging  
situated in the said town of Jerusalem containing one half  
an acre known and distinguished in the plan of the said town  
by the number sixteen thus N<sup>o</sup> 16 and called Vicks town  
lot To have and to hold to him the said Joshua Fort and his  
heirs forever the said lot of ground and its appurtenances  
to possess and enjoy the same free from all incumbrances or  
interruption - and the said James Rockelle for himself  
his heirs executors and administrators the said lot or half acre of
