Know all men by these presents that I Phebeella Bryant of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia for and in consideration of the natural love and affection which I bear towards my son Edwin Bryant of the same County the full receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have this day given granted bargained & sold and do hereby give grant bargain and sell unto the said Edwin Bryant his heirs and assigns forever one feather bed and furniture one flax wheel two hatchets one side saddle one powder dish one painted pine chest after my death to have and to hold the said property as above unto him the said Edwin Bryant his heirs and assigns forever and against the claim or claims of all and every person or persons whatsoever shall and well warrant and forever defend In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this first day of November 1812
