This Indenture made this 11th day of December in the year
of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twelve between
Samuel Pond and Dicia his wife and William Kitching of the
county of Southampton of the first part and Thomas Gray of
the county aforesaid of the second part Witnesseth that whereas
the said William Kitching and Sally his wife by their certain
deed of Indenture bearing date the eleventh day of November
in this present year did grant bargain sell alien enfeoff
confirm unto the said Samuel Pond his heirs executors admors
or assigns all that tract plantation and parcel of land
whereon the said William Kitching now lives being the same
whereon Joel Davis dec^d formerly lived and was purchased by
the said William Kitching of the representatives of the said Joel Davis
and bounded by the lands of John Morris Richard Blaw and
thence as the same was held and possessed by the said Joel Davis
dec^d in his life time by the most known and reputed boundaries
of the same as are of record to the said William Kitching from the
representatives of the said Joel Davis dec^d containing by estimation
one hundred and seventy one and an half acres be the same more
or less it being the remainder of the aforesaid tract of land and
at that time in the possession of the aforesaid William Kitching
after deducting for the alteration in the bounds of the said land
by the sale of nineteen acres by the said William Kitching to
John Morris and also by the sale of fifty acres by the said
William Kitching to John Pond Trade and all the right title
Interest claim and demand of the said William Kitching and Sally
his wife of in or to the said tract plantation and parcel of
