This Indenture made the 29th December 1812 between
Thomas Hosea of the County of Northampton and State of
North Carolina of the one part and Henry Bishop of the Coun-
ty of Southampton and State of Virginia of the other part
Witnesseth for in consideration of one hundred dollars in hand
paid have lease bargained and sold and confirmed unto the
said Henry Bishop of the County and State aforesaid ninety eight
acres of land lying and being in the County of Southampton
and State of Virginia to wit beginning on the Cabern swamp
and running Samuel Maggetts line to James Whitehead line
from thence along said line to a corner in said swamp from
thence along the various courses of said swamp to the first
Station To have and to hold the above mentioned premises to
Henry Bishop and his heirs during the life of said Thomas Hosea
or life of the said Henry Bishop reserve that the said Henry
Bishop is not at liberty to clear nor cultivate more than half
the tractable land above mentioned
