This Indenture made this _____ day of _____ year of our Lord Christ 1811 between John Blythe Junr and Petsey Blythe his wife of the county of Southampton one part and John Denegre of the same county of the other part Witnesseth that they the said John Blythe Junr and Petsey his wife for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars to them in hand paid by the said John Denegre the receipt whereof they the said John Blythe Junr and Petsey his wife do hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit and discharge the said John Denegre his heirs and assigns forever have granted bargained sold and delivered and by these presents do grant bargain sell alien enfeoff confirm and deliver unto him the said John Denegre and to his heirs and assigns one certain piece parcel and divided of land lying and being in the county of Southampton and Parish of Totterway being that portion of a tract of land whereof Michael Cobb died seized and possessed and which was assigned to the said John Blythe Junr in right of his wife Petsey late Petsey Cobb one of the heirs of said Michael Cobb by certain Commissioners appointed by a decree of the county Court of Southampton pronounced on the _____ day of _____ being had to that decree and the reports of the Commissioners made in pursuance thereof the bounds well fully appear and which said tract contains by actual survey sixty two and one half of an acre of land together with all and singular the appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining with the reversion and reversions remainders and remainders and all the right title interest claim and demand whatsoever of them the said John Blythe Junr and Petsey his wife of us and to the same and every part and parcel thereof - To have and to hold the said tract of land with the appurtenances unto him the said John Denegre and to his heirs and assigns forever, To the only proper use and behoof of him the said John Denegre and his heirs
