This Indenture made this 13<sup>th</sup> day of March in the year  
four hundred one thousand eight hundred and thirteen between Peter  
Pond and Anna his wife of Southampton county of the one part  
and John H. Pond of the same county of the other part Witnesseth  
that for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand dollars  
to them in hand paid by the said John H. Pond the receipt whereof  
is hereby acknowledged hath this day granted bargained and sold  
and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said  
John H. Pond his heirs or assigns forever one certain tract or parcel  
of land lying and being in the county aforesaid and containing by  
estimation three hundred acres it being the tract of land which  
formerly belonged to Bery Vaper dec<sup>d</sup> and fell by Descent to the  
said Anna Pond, and whereon the said Peter Pond and Anna  
his wife now lives and bounded by the lands of Richard Pond
