eight hundred and twelve between John Shields and Sally his wife
of the one part and Samuel Kitchen of the other part all of the
County of Southampton and state of Virginia. Witnesseth that
the said John Shields and Sally his wife doth for and in consideration
of the sum of sixty pounds to them in hand paid the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained sold aliened and confirm
ed and doth by these presents grant bargain sell alien and confirm
unto the said Samuel Kitchen his heirs and assigns forever one
certain tract and parcel of land lying and being in the County
of Southampton and on the north side of Round hill swamp
containing by estimation sixty acres be the same more or less
and bounded as follows (to wit) By the lines of Rice O Pierce John
Shields and Edward Branch, To have and to hold all and
singular the said land and premises above mentioned and
