This Indenture made this 15th day of February in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred and thirteen between Richard Vick and Charlotte his wife of the county of Southampton and state of Virginia of the one part and Samuel Calvert of the same county and state aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said Richard Vick & Charlotte his wife in consideration of the sum of eight hundred and twenty nine dollars and fifty cents lawful money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Samuel Calvert at or before the executing or delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents do and each of them doth bargain and sell unto the said Samuel Calvert his heirs and assigns two pieces or parcels of land situate lying and being in the County of Southampton and parish of Wotton and containing by a late survey two hundred and seventy six and one half acres be the same more or less being all the land purchased by Josiah Vick of Westons and a part of the Woodard tract and devised by the said Josiah to the said Richard Vick as will appear by reference being had to the will of the said Josiah Vick recorded in the County Court of Southampton, beginning at a Cypress standing
