I Benjamin Devany of the aforesaid county of
Southampton removed into this state of Virginia and county afore-
said about the 1st day of January last past and brought with
me one negro boy slave named Gilbert of the age of thirteen
years old very black and totrable spare

April 10th 1813 This day personally appeared before me Jeremiah
Cobb a justice of the peace for the county of Southampton Ben-
jamin Devany who made oath that the aforesaid statement
contains a true account of the aforesaid slave (Gilbert) and
that the said slave was not brought into this Commonwealth
for the purpose of sale or with the intent to evade the laws
of this Commonwealth - Given under my hand this day -

At a court held for the county of Southampton the day
