This Indenture made this twenty second day of March
the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred and thirteen
between Edmund Turner of Southampton County of the one
part and Samuel Blunt of the same county of the other
part Witnesseth that the said Edmund Turner for and
in consideration of the sum of six hundred and eighty four
dollars to him in hand paid by the said Samuel Blunt
the receipt whereof the said Edmund Turner doth hereby as
knowledge hath granted bargained and sold aliened and
confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell
alien and confirm unto the said Samuel Blunt his heirs
and assigns forever a certain tract of land lying and
being in the county of Southampton aforesaid containing
two hundred and twenty eight acres be the same more or less
and bounded as follows (to wit) beginning at the road leading
from Jerusalem to Bethlehem running thence South 40° E 31 1/2
to a willow oak a new corner in Nathaniel Boush's line
and Benjamin Barkams line thence N 32° East 28 poles
thence it 53° E. 14 poles thence N 72° East 28 poles to a turkey
oak a new marked tree standing on the edge of the high
land of buck horn swamp which is a very considerable
variation on the new made line between the said land and
Nathl Boush thence N 40° E thence it 55° East 21 poles to a
historic corner of Nathl Boush and Samuel Blunt from
thence North 12 West 142 poles to the first station
together with all the reversion and reversions remainder and
remainders rents issues and services of the said land and pre-
mises and likewise all the estate right title interest property
claim and demand whatsoever of the said Edmund Turner
of in and to the said land and premises and every part and
parcel thereof to have and to hold the said land and premises
unto the said Samuel Blunt his heirs and assigns forever

of the said Samuel Blunt his heirs and assigns forever and
