act of the General assembly passed on the 15th day of June
last concerning slaves Given under my hand and seal
this 16th day of March 1813

At a Court held for the county of Southampton the
day of April 1813 This Certificate of Lewis Woodell
having bought a slave from the state of N. Carolina
was presented to this court and ordered to be recorded

Whereas I am anxious to promote and set forward in
life my child Henry Bryant and until my death in

by these presents that I Charlotte Bryant from the na-
tural love and affection which I have and bear to my

right and use of my negro Peter during my life doth
give grant and make over the aforesaid negro man Peter
during my life doth give grant and make over the aforesaid
negro man Peter to him his heirs and assigns - To have
and to hold to my said son Henry (under the Condition
aforesaid) and his heirs and assigns forever. Witness my hand
and seal this 22nd day of September 1812
