Blows A Description of slaves brought into Virginia from North Carolina
by William Blows the same being acquired by marriage one negro
man named Sam of a yellow complexion about forty years old
Candis a mulatto woman aged twenty two years Sarah a black
woman aged eighteen years Howard a boy of a yellow comple-
xion aged four years the 17th of June next Turner a boy of a
yellow complexion aged one year last January Cherry a female
child aged one year
Wm Blows
17th March 1813

This day William Blows personally appeared before me a justice
of the peace for the county of Southampton and made oath that
the above statement is a true description of the slaves which he
hath brought into this Commonwealth that he acquired the
same by marriage in North Carolina and that he hath not
brought them into this commonwealth with an intention to
violate or evade any law of this Commonwealth to prohibit
the importation of slaves therein given under my hand this 17th
day of March 1813 -
