brook of the county of Southampton of the second part Witnesseth
that the said Thomas Hunt for divers considerations him thereunto
moving as well as for the further consideration of one dollar
lawful money of Virginia to him in hand paid the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged, he the said Thomas Hunt hath released
and confirmed and by these presents doth release and confirm unto the
said Henry J P Westbrook his heirs and assigns all his the said
Thomas Hunts interest claim or demand in and to a certain tract
or parcel of land lying and being in the county of Southampton
bounded as follows, beginning at a sweet gum on the run of the
three creeks a corner of Henry Applwhites land thence up the said
Applwhites line nearly a south course to a pine tree a corner
of Benjamin Lewiss land thence along the said Lewiss line near-
ly a west course to a white oak a corner tree in said Lewiss
