One hundred and thirty pounds fifteen shillings good
lawful money of Virginia the receipt whereof the said James
Jones doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained and
sold aliened enfeoffed & by these presents doth grant bargain
sell alien enfeoff one certain tract or parcel of land contain-
ing eighty five and 5/8 acres be the same more or less situated
lying and being in the county of Southampton and bounded
as follows Vtzt. beginning at a corner red oak in Nathaniel
Fitchens line thence along his line to Woods line and thence
along that line to a white oak a corner in John Monfrees
line thence along his line to a new marked line to a light
post in said Jones line thence S 79° W 13 pole to a corner
turkey oak in William West line thence N 34 East 76
pole to a new corner red oak thence S 80 East 122 1/2 pole
to the beginning or first station - also all trees Woods
underwoods Commons Common of pastures profits Communi-
ties Advantages emoluments and hereditaments whatsoever
to the said tract or parcel of land and also all the estate
right Interest claim & demand whatsoever of him the said
James Jones of in and to the said premises to have and to hold
all and singular the said premises and every part thereof
unto the said Anselm Jones his heirs &c and the said
James Jones warrants and forever defends the title of said
land unto the said Anselm Jones his heirs &c In Witness
