This Indenture made this seventeenth day of May A.D. one thousand eight hundred and thirteenth between Gray & Judkins of Suffolk county of the one part and Henry D. Inman of Southampton county of the other part Witnesseth that the said Gray & Judkins for and consideration of the sum of one hundred and forty dollars current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Henry D. Inman the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained sold and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said Henry D. Inman his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the county of Southampton on the south side of Little Swamp being a part of the land and plantation whereon Isaac Judkins deceased formerly lived and adjoining the lands of Richard Edmunds George Washington orphan of Thomas Washington dec. and George Bailey containing by a late survey twenty two acres be the same more or less together with all woods underwoods ways waters watercourses profits commodities advantages emoluments and hereditaments whatsoever to the said lands or in any wise appertaining the reversions and reversion remainders and remainders rents and profits of the same and every part thereof and all the estate right title claim interest and demand whatsoever of him the said Gray & Judkins his heirs &c of in and to the same and every part thereof To have and to hold the said land and premises appertaining to the true intent and meaning of these presents unto the said Henry D. Inman his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Henry D. Inman his heirs and assigns forever all be the said Gray & Judkins for himself his heirs and assigns do covenant grant promise and agree to and with the said Henry
