This Indenture made this fifth day of February in the
 year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and thirteen
 Between David Myrick and Phebe his wife of the county of
 Southampton and state of Virginia of the one part and
 Ethelred Edmunds of the same county and state of the other
 part Witnesseth that the said David Myrick and Phebe
 his wife have for and in consideration of the sum of seven
 hundred and fifty dollars to them in hand paid by the
 said Ethelred Edmunds before the enrolling and delivery of
 these presents the receipt whereof the said David Myrick and
 Phebe his wife do hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit
 and discharge the said Ethelred Edmunds and his heirs and
 assigns forever and themselves therewith fully and entirely
 satisfied contented and paid the said David Myrick and
 Phebe his wife have granted bargained and sold and by these
 presents do grant bargain sell alien enfeoff release set
 over deliver and confirm unto the said Ethelred Edmunds
 and to his heirs and assigns forever a certain piece parcel
 tract and dividend of land which was allotted and assigned
 to the said David Myrick by certain commissioners appointed
 by the county court of Southampton by a interlocutory decree
 of that court pronounced on the 16th of December 1811 decreed
 -ing a division of the lands ^{whereof} of Samuel Edmunds dec^d and
 and possessed in pursuance of the testament and last will
 of the said Samuel Edmunds dec^d which will is of record
 in the county Court of Southampton which said tract or
 dividend of land contains by survey four hundred and ninety
 acres and bounded as follows to wit beginning at a post or
 new made corner in the cross line running thence ^{to the} S 55° E
 186 poles to a red oak a new corner made in Mrs Whitehead's
 line thence S 75° East 38 poles to where there was a corner
 tree near the house thence S 6° West 76 poles thence S 11°
