Schedule of Sundry Negroes brought into the state of Virginia
under the authority of an act of the Legislature of said state
passed the 15th day of January 1813 as follows -

Negro man named Jeharo - about 35 years old

Boy Peter - " - 10 - "

James Lee this day made oath be
fore me that the above is a true statement of the negroes brought
by him into this state and that they were not brought therein
for the purpose of sale or to evade the laws of this Commonwealth
to prevent the further importation of slaves or in any manner
contrary to the act and provisions thereof Given under my
hand this 6th day of March 1813 -
