This Indenture made this eleventh day of July in the year of our lord 1813 between Elizabeth Vick of Southampton of the one part and Joshua Fort of the county of Jerusalem of the other part. Witnesseth the said Elizabeth Vick for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars to her in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath given granted bargained sold and delivered and doth hereby give grant sell set over and release to and in favour of the said Fort all her right title Interest and claim of every kind whatever as well her dower right in the estate of the late Joseph Vick dec'd as all claim of every kind to and in a certain lot in the town of Jerusalem siting and known by the name of Vicks Tavern lot and numbered in the plan of the said town. To have and to hold to him the said Fort his heirs and assigns forever, all and singular her rights and interest in the said lot and its appurtenances to possess and enjoy the same in as full and ample manner as she herself might or could do releasing hereby to him the said Fort every kind of claim accruing to her in consequence of her intermarriage with the said Joseph Vick dec'd her late husband. In Witness whereof she the said Elizabeth Vick hath the day and year above written set her hand and seal hereto.
