In conformity to the within commission to us directed we have examined the within mentioned Rebecca Tynes privately and apart from her husband whether she signed the annexed Indenture freely and voluntarily without the threats or persuasions of her husband and also whether she is willing the same should be recorded in the county court of Southampton to which query she answered that she signed the annexed Indenture voluntarily and was willing the same should be recorded in the court aforesaid, given under our hands and seals this 9th day of December 1812
