in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred and thirteen

and Patsy Dillard of the said county of the other part Witnesseth
that the said Winney Turner Solomon Turner & wife Sally

Temperance Turner and Nancy Turner for and in considera-
tion of the sum of nineteen hundred and sixty dollars to them
hand paid by the said Patsy Dillard before the signing sealing
and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof the said Winney
Turner Solomon Turner and wife Sally Samuel Cook and
wife Leucy Benjamin Jones and wife Patsy Temperance
Turner and Nancy Turner do hereby acknowledge themselves
therewith fully satisfied contented and paid have bargained &
sold, aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents
doth hereby bargain sell enfeoffed and confirm unto the
said Patsy Dillard her heirs and assigns a certain tract or
parcel of land lying and being situated in the county of
Southampton, and bounded as followeth by Simon Boykins
land & the swamp and Solomon Turners containing two hun-
dred acres be the same more or less together with all houses
profits and commodities thereunto belonging or in any wise ap-
pertaining with all the estate right title claim or demand
of them the said Winney Turner Solomon Turner and wife Sally
Samuel Cook and wife Leucy Benjamin Jones & wife Patsy
Temperance Turner and Nancy Turner to have and to hold
the said bargained premises with every of the appurtenances
unto the said Patsy Dillard her heirs and assigns forever and

& assigns claims and releases unto the said Patsy Dillard
