This Indenture made this fourteenth day of September One thousand eight hundred and thirteen between Allington Edwards and Ann his wife of the county of Southampton and state of Virginia of the one part and Elias Bracey of the said county and state of the other part Witnesses that the said Allington Edwards and Ann his wife for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and forty five dollars good and lawful money of Virginia in hand paid by the said Elias Bracey the receipt of which said sum the said Allington Edwards and Ann his wife doth hereby acknowledge themselves fully and entirely satisfied, have bargained sold set over and delivered and by these presents do bargain sell set over and deliver unto the said Elias Bracey his heirs and assigns forever, a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the county and state aforesaid, beginning at a point standing near the road thence along the road to a dogwood thence the various courses to the beginning as will more fully appear from a deed executed by Allington Jones to me
