 eight hundred and thirteen between Jacob Vick of South-
 ampton county of the one part and James Barnes on the other

 granted and by these presents doth give and grant unto the said
 James Barnes a parcel of land containing thirty two acres
 bounded thus beginning at a pine a corner of Everetts land
 thence by Everetts line to the Cypress road thence by the road
 northward to Jacksons land thence by the same to a pine a
 corner tree thence to the beginning to have and to hold the said
 land and appurtenances to the said James Barnes his heirs
 and assigns forever, In Witness whereof I have hereunto
