This Indenture made this 26th day of September one thousand eight hundred and thirteen between Elizabeth Turner of the one part and Isaac Jenkins of the other part witnesseth that the said Elizabeth Turner for and in consideration of the sum of thirty two dollars good and lawful money to him in hand paid by the said Isaac Jenkins the receipt whereof the said Elizabeth Turner doth hereby acknowledge and thereby acquit and discharge the said Isaac Jenkins his heirs executors and administrators and himself to be therewith contented satisfied and paid hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien enfeoff confirm set over and deliver unto him the said Isaac Jenkins and his heirs executors and administrators one certain tract and parcel of land situate lying and being in the county of Southampton and parish of Stotterway beginging at a pine in Slave branch thence down the meanders of said branch to the junction in Jones's Mill pond to high water mark and thence up the said pond as it meanders at high water marks to a new corner pine on the side of said pond thence a new line of marked trees S. 5 W to the beginning To have and to hold all and singular the premises aforesaid with its appurtenances unto him the said Isaac Jenkins and to his heirs and assigns forever unto the only use and behoof of him the said Isaac Jenkins and to his heirs and assigns forever and the said Elizabeth Turner for herself her heirs executors and administrators hereby covenants promises covenants and agrees to and with the said Isaac Jenkins and to his heirs executors and administrators and assigns forever against the claim and demands of all persons whatsoever In witness whereof the said Elizabeth Turner hath hereunto set her hand and affixed her seal in the day and date within written
